ANNEX "A" MANDATORY RANDOM DRUG TEST

CLARIFICATIONS/AMENDMENTS

	Query/Clarifications	TWG/BAC Secretariat Reply
6.1.	How is the 3,982 employees distributed?	The 3,982 employees will be distributed for drug testing as 200 employees per day intermittently until the total number of employees has been covered until December 2019.
6.2.	Will the TWG conduct ocular inspection on the nearest prospective bidder?	No. Ocular Inspection of the clinic will only be conducted during the post-qualification evaluation of the Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB).
6.3	How long should the bidder keep the urine samples in case of a request for a confirmatory test?	Confirmatory results may be contested within 15 calendar days, but the project requires the storage of the urine samples for 30 days.
6.4	The bidders requested for a confidential schedule of the random tests so that they may secure the permit from DOH to conduct drug tests.	Noted. To be provided by the TWG.
6.5	How long will the delivery period of the project be?	Until the required 3,982 employees were tested which must be before the end of year 2019.
6.6	Does the project calls for a medical technician for the frisking and inspection before the collection of urine samples?	Yes, 4 trained personnel shall conduct the frisking and inspection before and during the collection of urine samples.
6.7	Will the winning bidder be required to provide the drinking water?	Yes, preferably sealed bottled drinking water or water dispenser maybe provided.
